# *Lazy Arvo Grenache*

BAROSSA VALLEY

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There is nothing lazy about how this wine is made, with hard work, great dirt, old vines, and meticulous winemaking. Our Grenache grapes are grown on a single vineyard within the Western Ridge of Barossa Valley, in the famous sub-region of Stonewell that is often referred to as the golden mile.

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A perfectly balanced, medium-bodied Grenache with vibrant crushed strawberry flavours and hints of rhubarb, orange peel and light spice. Fine tannins with a clean, crunchy finish.

Handpicked at dawn between mid-February and mid-March, the blend of early-picked and later-picked parcels allowed for maximum extraction of tannins and riper flavours. Once through Malo fermentation, the wines were combined and racked in seasoned French oak barrels.
