# All Day Rosé

BAROSSA VALLEY

There's something amazingly drinkable about our Rosé, hence the name. All Day Rosé is made with Grenache grapes sourced from the Tscharke family in Barossa Valley's western ridge, Marananga, who has been farming his land for six generations.

In the hands of our winemaker Clarkey, these grapes are transformed into a very smashable Rosé.

Salmon pink in colour, this wine has red fruit flavours of watermelon and wild strawberry, with hints of spice, rose petals, and olive, finishing with fresh and zesty lemon.

Grapes are handpicked in February from a small single vineyard on the Tscharke estate. Handpicked earlier in February, then basket pressed with free-run juice left to settle in tank somewhere between four to seven degrees. Gentle stirring occasionally happens to assist the lees and generate flavours and structure.
