# Lazy Arvo Grenache

BAROSSA VALLEY

There is nothing lazy about how this wine is made, with hard work, great dirt, old vines, and meticulous blending! It's a unique blend of Grenache from the sub-regions of Stockwell and Rowland Flat in Barossa Valley. These sub-regions are the southernmost point of Barossa Valley's central grounds, and generally, soils are deep sand over clay

A beautiful red in colour, this wine shows sweet red berry fruits, spice and hints of licorice, soft tannins and well-balanced acidity. And just like the wine itself, flavours are generous and vibrant.

Picked in late March at optimal ripeness, encouraging maximum red berry flavour and the soft tannins we look for in Tin Shed winemaking.

Grapes are crushed into an open fermenter and once through malofermentation, they are placed into a selection of aged French oak for further maturation, texture and structure.
